Over the years some of you have encouraged **Jason Shipman**, who is serving a life sentence. Recently, Jason was selected as one of 48 inmates, out of 787 applicants in the prison system, for the Dynamo Program. Dynamo started in Norway and is designed for inmates with no chance of being released. He has moved from level 5 (most secure) prison to a level 2. He has his own cell with his own DVD player. His wing has couches, plants, an aquarium with live fish, and a large screen TV. Also, a mini fridge and mini deep freezer, washer and dryer, ice machine and two microwaves. This wing is an actual trustworthy place. His wing always eats first and they have access to the yard to walk around, run, lift weights or play guitar or go workout in the gym. Jason says the most wonderful thing is we are considered good guys of all inmates. There are never any correctional officers or staff in this wing unless they have a reason to come down. Inmates are counted three times a day, correctional officers count and then leave! Jason left the Bible college at Jefferson City because proposed legislature may give these inmates a chance of freedom. They are allowed to go on field trips to Wal-Mart to shop. Jason is excited to be a part of Dynamo.
