“But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God’s own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; for you once were not a people, but now you are the people of God; you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.”



As we become acquainted with individuals who are incarcerated, we learn about the hardships their family members deal with in their absence. Some have elderly or unhealthy parents who may pass away during the incarceration of their child. Some have children who require surgeries or have chronic illnesses. Some family members lack time, road-worthy vehicles and adequate funds for food, fuel and overnight accommodations if they want to visit their loved one in a county jail or prison. Interestingly, because Texas is such a large state, family members can request that their loved one be granted a “hardship” transfer and be reassigned to a prison unit close to the family. Considerations are given to the incarcerated individual who is over 200 miles from home and/or their family member is unable to travel long distances due to a medical condition.
