A group of advocates for criminal justice and immigration reform, has revealed that over half of all families in the United States have been impacted by mass incarceration. How does incarceration change behavior? Incarceration, especially when it involves longer and harsher prison sentences, can significantly alter an individual's behavior and personality. Key features of the prison environment that are likely to lead to personality change include the chronic loss of free choice, lack of privacy, daily stigma, frequent fear, need to wear a constant mask of invulnerability and emotional flatness (to avoid exploitation by others), and the requirement, day after day, to follow externally imposed stringent rules and routines. Imagine the constant pressure of living in a confined space, devoid of personal autonomy or emotional connections.
